Junior Yachtsman of the Year Award

Deed of Gift

The Junior Yachtsman of the Year Award shall be conferred annually by the Dana Point Yacht Club to a Junior who embodies the Corinthian spirit both on and off of the water. The recipient will be an individual who displays honor, integrity, sportsmanship, generosity, courtesy, seamanship and a love and respect of yachting and the sea as recongnized by his or her peers.

This award shall consist of a perpetual trophy known as the Dana Point Yacht Club Junior Yachtsman of the Year Trophy, which will be presented at the Junior Awards Ceremony. Each year the recipient's name and year will be placed on a plaque affixed to the trophy at DPYC expense. In addition the winner will be presented a take home memento engraved with the recipient's name, year awarded and the full name of the award.

This award shall be presented to just one junior in a calendar year. Nominees may be a current Junior Flag Officer.

Nominations for this award may be presented in writing by all of the juniors throughout the current year to the the Junior Sailing Director. A nomination form will be available on the club website. The coaches will also have a right to submit their nominations to the Junior Sailing Director. Two weeks before the Junior Awards Ceremony the coaches and the Junior Sailing Director will review all nominations and make the final selection.

This Deed of Gift shall become effective upon its approval by a majority vote of the Dana Point Yacht Club Board of Directors.

The Dana Point Yacht Club Board of Directors shall have the authority to modify any of the provisions of this Deed of Gift by a majority vote.

This Deed of Gift is approved by the Board of Directors of Dana Point Yacht Club on August 18, 2014.
