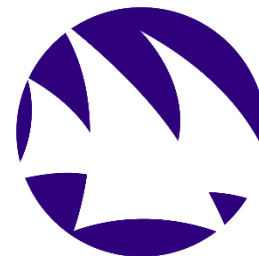

NOTICE OF RACE

ORGANIZING AUTHORITY / MANAGEMENT -The organizing authority for this regatta is the Dana Point Harbor Youth Foundation. The Dana Point Yacht Club Race Committee will manage this regatta and shall appoint a protest committee and accept or reject the entry of any boat.

RULES -The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing and this Notice of Race shall govern all races except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions.

ELIGIBILITY -This regatta is open to all skippers and crew of CFJs, RS Teras, C420s, Lasers, Optis, and Capri 14. Senior Division entrants will sail in the RS Tera Class.

LOANER BOATS – A limited supply of loaner boats are available. If you would like to inquire as to availability, complete the [Online Registration Form](#). Following regatta registration, contact Donna Carter at jamr@dphyf.org with your registration information, age, experience level, and contact information. Until you receive a confirmation we cannot guarantee the availability of a loaner boat.

ENTRIES - Completed entries must be received by DPYC before 0900 hours, Saturday, March 3, 2018. Sail numbers for those with loaner boats must be provided to registration desk by 0900 hours. Only skippers need to register. Entry fee – \$30 single-handed classes, \$45 double-handed classes. T-Shirts and Power Snack & Water included in registration.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS -Sailing Instructions and other important information will be issued Saturday during the skipper's meeting. Changes to Sailing Instructions will be posted 30 minutes after the skipper's meeting or by 1030 hours.

COURSES / VENUE – The racing area will be in the ocean approx. 400 yards outside of the harbor entrance where the R/C Signal Boat will be stationed. The Sailing Instructions will include a course chart and schedule of races.

CHANGES TO RULES – Rule 44 will be changed in the SIs so that if an incident occurs outside the zone for a rounding or finishing mark the penalty will be a One-Turn Penalty.

SCORING/ Five (5) races are scheduled of which two (2) must be completed to constitute a regatta. The Low Point scoring system will apply except RRS Appendix A, as modified herein, no throw outs will apply.

TROPHIES – Trophies will be awarded to 1st place skippers and crew in each class. Classes with 6 or more boats will include 2nd place trophies as well. In addition, an award will be presented to the most Corinthian competitor, as voted upon by his/her peers. All participants will receive the JAMR Commemorative competitor keepsake.

FACILITIES –Visitors to our harbor will rig and launch from the OC Sailing & Events Center (OCSEC) located at 34451 Ensenada PI, Dana Point, CA 92629 but store their trailers in the designated area of the DPYC parking lot located at 24399 Dana Drive, Dana Point, CA 92629. Water shuttles will be available between the OCSEC and DPYC. Boats will remain docked at the OCSEC until after the skipper's meeting. Racers will check-in, rig their boats and attend the Skipper's Meeting at OCSEC. All competitors must wet rig.
