NOTICE OF RACE & GENERAL CONDITIONS

- **ORGANIZING AUTHORITY & MANAGEMENT** – The organizing authority for this Regatta is Dana Point Yacht Club (DPYC) and Cabrillo Beach Yacht Club (CBYC). The Race Committees of both clubs will manage this race jointly.
- **RULES** This race shall be governed by the Rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) with U.S. Sailing prescriptions, the rules of PHRF of Southern California (PHRF), the rules of any participating classes, this Notice of Race, except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions. This regatta is classified as a Category A event in accordance with ISAF, Regulation 20
- **ELIGIBILITY** The race is open to ocean racing / cruising sailing vessels whose owners or charterers are members of a yacht club recognized by US Sailing or SCYA. All boats must conform to USCG and US Sailing requirements. All PHRF and One-Design class boats must conform to the Category 2 requirements of the PHRF Rulebook currently in effect. All boats, *except Cruising classes*, must have a valid current PHRF rating certificate. Cruising class boats that have a PHRF certificate should submit it. The Race Committee will assign a rating to any Cruising class boat that does not have a PHRF rating certificate.
- **SAFETY EQUIPMENT** All boats, *except Cruising classes*, shall satisfy the Standard Equipment requirements for a Category 2 race as set forth in the current PHRF Rulebook. Cruising classes shall satisfy the Standard Equipment requirements for a Category 3 race as set forth in the current PHRF Rulebook.
- **FLEET / CLASSES** PHRF, Double-Handed and Cruising boats will each have their own fleet. The PHRF and Cruising fleets will be divided into classes based upon the type and number of entries. One-Design classes will be part of the PHRF fleet. Class breaks will be based upon the boat's PHRF OWC rating or committee assigned rating. Non-Spinnaker offsets and rating adjustments for fixed prop, roller furling, jib and main size & material will be used for the Cruising class(es). Skippers will be notified in the Sailing Instructions included in their race packet as to the class in which they will compete. Anticipated classes are PHRF AA, A, B, C, D, Double-Handed, Cruising and Cruising N/S. The Race Committee may establish classes for five (5) or more entries.
- **ENTRIES** The DPYC Race Committee must receive an entry and fee of \$75 by **May 24, 2010**, after which the late entry fee will be \$100. **The entry deadline is 1800 hours, May 28, 2010.** Online entry is available on the DPYC website and the date stamp of the online entry will be your entry date once payment is completed. All boats, *except Cruising class entries that do not have a PHRF rating certificate*, must submit a copy of your **current PHRF Rating Certificate** along with their entry unless on file with DPYC or online validation is available. Online entries, if applicable mail your PHRF Certificate to DPYC, Attn: John Berry, 24399 Dana Drive, Dana Point, CA 92629. Mailed entries, make check payable to Dana Point Yacht Club and mail all to DPYC as indicated above. Any entry received after the deadline may be accepted or returned at the Race Committee's discretion.
- **COURSE** This is an offwind course race. First start will be at 1130 hours. The start line will be defined in the Sailing Instructions and will be located inside the Los Angeles Harbor approximately one-mile northeast of the Los Angeles Lighthouse. All PHRF, One-Design and Double-Handed classes shall leave Catalina Island to port. **HANDICAP COURSE LENGTH - 75 NM.** Cruising classes shall exit LA Harbor at Angel's Gate and sail their best course to finish. **HANDICAP COURSE LENGTH IS -34 NM.** The finish line shall be defined by the green light on the East End of the Dana Point Harbor outer breakwater and the DPYC Committee boat anchored northerly thereof. The Sailing Instructions will include a complete description. Chart 18751 covers Los Angeles and Long Beach Harbors. **Chart 18746** covers the entire racecourse.

- **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS** A race packet including the Sailing Instructions and additional information will be issued to each boat prior to the start of the race. It is the skipper's responsibility to pick up their race packet prior to the race. Packets may be picked up at CBYC between 1800-2200 hours on Friday, May 28 and 0900-1000 hours Saturday, May 29. The race packet will also include a starting schedule, class breakdowns, entry lists with time allowances and information regarding docking at DPYC.
- **TROPHIES** The trophy presentation will be at approximately 1900 hours on Sunday, May 30. Perpetual trophies will be awarded to: the first PHRF Fleet boat to finish; and *on corrected time*, the first PHRF Fleet boat overall, first PHRF Catalina boat and first Cruising fleet Catalina boat. Take home trophies will be awarded in customary numbers to all classes, as well as to, the *First to Finish* and *First Overall* PHRF boats. Double-Handed boats will receive two trophies per boat.
- **FACILITIES** Cabrillo Beach Yacht Club is located at Berth 35 in the Cabrillo Marina, 211 West 22nd Street, San Pedro. Please call CBYC for slip availability and arrival information. CBYC office phone is (310) 519-1694. CBYC can be contacted on VHF channel 16 and crews will be available to assist boats upon arrival Friday afternoon or evening. Restrooms and showers are available. Dana Point Yacht Club will obtain as many slips as possible for use by race participants over the weekend. **Slip assignments at both clubs will be on a priority basis, assigned by order of receipt of entry. Enter early to improve your chances of obtaining a slip.** If necessary, boats may anchor in the west basin of Dana Point harbor. Boats should be prepared to anchor bow and stern. DPYC will provide shore boat service to anchored boats. Upon finishing, follow the instructions in the race packet for slip or anchoring assignment at Dana Point. A 3,000-lb. hoist will be available. The DPYC facilities will be available for use by skippers, crew and guests throughout the weekend.
- **DINING**

DANA POINT YACHT CLUB will offer a selection of entrées in the dining room, as well as, appetizers and bar food upstairs at the "Oyster Bar" from 1800 hours to 2100 hours Saturday and Sunday with the bar remaining open until later. Breakfast will be available on Sunday at 1000 hours.

CABRILLO BEACH YACHT CLUB will offer your choice of a steak, fish, or Chef's Choice" dinner on Friday night from 1800 to 2100 hours. *Reservations needed.* Saturday morning a complimentary continental breakfast will be available. The CBYC bar will be open Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.

In consideration of your acceptance of my entry, I and my crew hereby certify, agree and acknowledge, as follows:

- 1) I certify that the rating entered hereon is valid, and that I will sail in accordance with this rating.
- 2) I will comply with all of the rules and regulations of the Dana Point Yacht Club ("DPYC"), Cabrillo Beach Yacht Club ("CBYC"), the ISAF, US Sailing, the US Coast Guard, the fleet entered class association rules as applicable, any other applicable governing body, and any other instructions under which this race is sailed.
- 3) Any contestant, under the supervision of the Race Committee, may inspect my boat, before or after the race.
- 4) I and my crew are entering the race and related race activities entirely at our own risk of personal injury or property damage, and it is my sole and exclusive responsibility to decide whether or not to start or to continue the race due to weather conditions or otherwise. I am the owner or charterer of my boat. My boat is in good condition, seaworthy, and fully complies with the equipment rules and regulations of the fleet in which it is entered.
- 5) To the fullest extent allowed by law, I and my crew hereby release DPYC and any other sponsoring yacht club or organization, their officers, directors and race personnel from any and all liability whatsoever for any injury to myself, my crew, or others, including death, and damage to my boat or other boats, arising out of my and my crew's participation in the race, or any activities related to the race, to the extent that such release does not discharge my insurance carrier under the provisions of insurance policies on my boat.
- 6) I will notify DPYC immediately upon withdrawal from the race and will not thereafter sail in hazardous conflict with any other boat or commercial vessel.
