



# SSYC/DPYC Ensenada Tune-up Regatta

Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions  
Saturday, April 5, 2008



## Relevant Dates:

**Race Start:** Saturday, April 5, 2008 – 1200

**Entries Due:** Wednesday, April 2, 2008 at SSYC

**PreRace Dinner:** 6:30pm, Friday Night, April 4 at SSYC

**PreRace Party:** 8:00 pm, Friday Night, April 4 at SSYC

**Post Race Dinner:** Saturday Night, April 5 at DPYC – Bar menu 4-9pm, Downstairs Dinner from 6:00pm

**Rules:** The race will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2005-2008, the Prescriptions of US Sailing, the Class Rules of the PHRF of Southern California, and this Notice of Race and Sailing instructions. This Race is a PHRF Category 4 race.

**Eligibility:** The race is open to members of yacht clubs and sailing associations recognized by the Southern California Yachting Assoc. (SCYA) or US SAILING. Yachts in PHRF Classes must have a valid 2008 PHRF certificate. Yachts in Cruising Class without a PHRF certificate will be accepted and will be assigned a rating by the race committee.

**Ratings:** PHRF OWC ratings will be used without area adjustments.

**Entries:** Entries will be accepted through Wednesday, April 2, 2008. The entry form, the entry fee of \$40 payable to SSYC, and a copy of the boat's 2008 PHRF rating certificate (for those in PHRF Classes) should be mailed to SSYC. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee.

**Classes:** PHRF Spinnaker and Cruising Classes will be established by the Race Committee. Cruising Class boats may not use a spinnakers or gennakers. Double headsails will be allowed.

**Double Handed PHRF Spinnaker:** To more completely represent the classes of the NOSA Newport to Ensenada Race we are including a Double Handed PHRF Spinnaker class within the PHRF Spinnaker Class. Boats competing for this trophy will sail with a crew of two. This modifies PHRF class Rule 10.5.

**Notice to Competitors, Changes in Sailing Instructions:** There will be no competitor's meeting. Any changes to this Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions will be posted on the Race Notice Board across from the DPYC front door and on the Race Notice Board at SSYC by 1900 hours on Friday, April 4, 2008.

**Class Breaks, Class Flags, and Order of Start:** Class Breaks, Class Flags, and Order of Start will be posted on the DPYC and SSYC Race Notice Boards by 1900 hours on Friday, April 4, 2008. They will also be displayed on the Race Committee boat prior to the first Warning.

**Pre-Race Check-in:** All boats must check-in with the SSYC Race Committee boat when it is anchored in the starting area displaying code flag "L" and be recognized prior to the warning signal for the first start. Any boat failing to comply will be scored DNS.

**The Start:** The starting area will be approximately ½ mile east of Balboa Pier. The start line will be between an orange flag on the port end and an orange or red flag on or near the race committee boat on the starboard end. The race will be started using RRS 26. First Warning will be 1200. In event of heavy weather preventing the setting of the line outside the harbor, the starting area will be made inside Newport Harbor, in the channel midway between the Pavilion and the Harbor Patrol docks. Racers are to monitor Ch 68 at 1030 and 1100 for any announcement regarding any change to the starting area.

**The Course:** Start, Dana Point red "R2" whistle buoy to port, Finish. Handicap distance is 14.3 miles.

**The Finish:** Finish will be between the green G5 navigation aid (flG4sec) on the Dana Point Harbor south entrance jetty and an orange or red flag on the Race Committee boat. The Race Committee Boat will be anchored approximately 100 yards NE of the green light. Boats will finish by turning at the green light as if to enter the Harbor. **Caution is advised** when making this maneuver.

**Time Limit:** The time limit will be 1800. Boats failing to finish within the time limit, or within 30 minutes after the first boat in its class finishes, whichever is later, will be scored DNF (this modifies RRS 35).

**Retiring:** A competitor that has checked-in and subsequently retires from the race prior to finishing shall notify the Race Committee by hail or by VHF Channel 68 and be acknowledged before leaving the race course, or if that is impossible, shall contact the Race Committee at DPYC immediately upon arriving ashore. DPYC phone number is 949-496-2900.

**Protests:** A competitor intending to file a protest or request for redress shall notify the Race Committee on the finish boat and be acknowledged before leaving the finish area. A protest or request for redress must be filed within one hour of the protesting boat's finish time to be eligible for a hearing.

**Trophies:** Trophies will be presented at DPYC at approx. 2000 hours on Saturday, April 5.
