NOTICE OF RACE

1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY & MANAGEMENT

The organizing authority for this Regatta is Dana Point Yacht Club (DPYC). The Dana Point Yacht Club Race Committee will manage this Regatta and shall have sole authority to interpret rules and conditions of the race, appoint a protest committee and accept or reject the entry of any boat.

2. RULES

This race shall be governed by the Rules, as defined in the 2009 - 2012 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the Deed of Gift for the Howard Trueba Memorial Trophy. A copy of the [Deed of Gift](#) may be obtained on the DPYC website. This regatta is classified as a Category A event in accordance with ISAF, Regulation 20 and as a PHRF Category 4 race. All boats shall comply with the PHRF standard equipment requirements of that category.

3. ELIGIBILITY

This is an invitational regatta. To be eligible, a skipper must have won a first place trophy since the prior year's Harbor Championship Regatta in an unrestricted class, in a race or regatta where the race starts and finishes in Dana Point Harbor and is sponsored by a Dana Point Harbor yacht club. Additionally, the skipper must be a member of a yacht club recognized by US Sailing or SCYA.

4. ENTRY

Invited skippers may enter by completing a DPYC General Entry Form and submitting it to the Race Committee at Dana Point Yacht Club by the **entry deadline of 1800 hours, Friday, October 23, 2009**. If a skipper is eligible in more than one boat, they must elect one and submit their chosen entry by the entry deadline. If there are qualifying co-skippers, they may enter the Regatta as co-skippers, but one of them shall be designated as the primary helmsman on the entry form. If the Race Committee cannot verify the boat's current PHRF valid status, a copy of the boat's current PHRF Certificate will be required prior to the entry deadline. 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be posted on the DPYC website. Any Amendments to the Sailing Instructions and further information will be provided at the skipper's meeting scheduled for 0930 Saturday, October 24, 2009.

6. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Saturday, October 24, 2009
0830 - Racer's breakfast
0930 - Skipper's meeting
1055 – 1st Warning Signal
Party following racing at DPYC

Sunday, October 25, 2009
1055 – 1st Warning Signal
1700 - Trophy Presentations

7. RACES SCHEDULED

Five (5) races are scheduled. Four windward-leeward or Olympic style races are scheduled for Saturday and one random leg race on Sunday. Depending upon Saturday's wind conditions, it is possible that some windward-leeward races may be run on Sunday. The first Warning Signal each day will be at 1055 hours. At least three races shall be sailed and scored to complete the regatta.

8. CLASSES

There will be only one class. All boats will start together.

9. HELMSMAN

The invited qualifying skipper shall be the primary helmsman in all races. If multiple skippers qualify by winning a race in which they were entered as co-skippers, they may enter the Regatta as co-skippers but one of them shall be designated as the primary helmsman.

10. SCORING

The Low-Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A will apply. A boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races. This changes RRS A2.

11. RATING SYSTEM

This regatta will be scored using PHRF Area E handicaps. Windward-Leeward and Olympic style course races will be scored with Buoy ratings and the random leg race will be scored with Random Leg ratings.

12. TROPHIES & AWARDS

The Howard Trueba Memorial Trophy, a perpetual trophy, will be awarded to the overall winner of the Regatta. The winning skipper will be designated as this year's Dana Point Harbor Champion. Take home trophies will be awarded through 5th place. Participation awards will be presented to all entrants.

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS:

All skippers, their crew, club members, and guests are invited to the *Racer's Breakfast* from 0830 to 1000 hours, upstairs before the race on Saturday.

A party with hors d'oeuvres and music will follow racing on Saturday. All skippers, their crew, club members, and guests are invited.
