**2009 RHD Charity Fishing Tournament**  
Saturday, September 12th

## **Rules and Regulations**

This tournament is open to all fishermen who register, pay the fee, and abide by the following tournament rules:

1. **The main objective of the fishing tournament is to raise money for the Institute and for the anglers and skippers to have a great day on the water.**
2. All anglers must have paid and registered prior to the fishing start time on the day they wish to compete.
3. All fish to be considered for the tournament must be caught:
  - a. On Saturday Sept. 12<sup>th</sup> between the hours of 6:00 AM and 4:00 PM
4. **First prize is a TN20 TRINADAD reel and second prize is a SHIMANO TEREMAR casting rod** which will be awarded to the anglers who acquire the most points according to the following schedule:
  - Marlin, Mako or Thresher of legal size (over 80lbs) - 25 points +  
+ 5 extra points for a release
  - Yellowtail, Dorado and Tuna over 15lbs - 20 points
  - Yellowtail, Dorado and Tuna under 15lbs - 15 points
  - White Sea Bass & Halibut - 15 points
  - Other Bass, barracuda - 5 points
  - Other fish - 2 points
5. In the event of a point tie, the heaviest fish of those anglers who tied wins.
6. All fish must be caught on rod and reel. Fish caught by any other method will be disqualified.
7. Fish can be caught with natural bait or artificial lures.
8. In the event of any dispute, the judge's decision will be final.

The following are reasons for disqualification:

1. Not abiding by the rules
2. Bag limits must be observed. Any angler keeping more than their daily bag limit will have all fish disqualified.
3. Allowing any person to fish on the boat other than tournament registered fishermen.
4. Any fish that is wounded by propeller, shark bite, harpoon, bullet or with any visible mangling (other than a hook or gaff wound).
5. Any participant issuing any verbal insults and/or physical aggression against the judge, tournament staff, or any other registered anglers.
